THE PRESIDENT & CEO

For much of 2011. Planned Parenthood was a news headliner. From early morning TV to late night comedy and every news medium in between. Planned Parenthood and women's health were in the spotlight.

Even in the face of political rhetoric and attacks by the opposition, Planned Parenthood's national commitment to ensuring quality health care remained strong. In 2011, nearly 3 million women, men and teens were served by 82 affiliates at 800 health centers throughout the United States.

Planned Parenthood of Metropolitan New Jersey (PPMNJ) is proud of its' contribution to those astonishing numbers. Despite a \$1.3 million dollar cut in NJ State funding, PPMNJ served almost 20,000 clients who made 29,000 visits to our health centers in 2011. Our Family Life Institute continues to provide vital educational programs. Four hundred workshops were presented to over 8,700 individuals. Remarkable!

Reflecting on the challenges of the year, reminds me that there were also reasons and opportunities to celebrate. Planned Parenthood Federation of America has an intensive evaluation process which is used to ensure that standards of excellence are met. PPMNJ successfully met the affiliation requirements and was awarded full accreditation for 2011-2014. In October at our "People Who Make a Difference" reception, we honored three deserving individuals, Senator Ronald Rice, Joseph Alifante and Ruth Bedford, along with the Peirels Foundation for their significant contributions to our mission.

After a year as interim CEO, the Board of Trustees named me President and CEO. I am honored to serve in this capacity. For me, Planned Parenthood is not a political position or an abstract ideal. It has been a transformative force in my life. Over 30 years ago, as a teen ager, I walked into a Planned Parenthood office the first time for a summer job assignment. Unfamiliar with the organization, I did not know the professional and personal impact the experience would provide. I often say that summer shaped my direction by giving me the tools needed to make responsible choices, share information with friends and craft the stage for what has become my life's work.

The board and staff of PPMNJ's commitment to champion our collective vision of reproductive freedom for all is strong and our resolve is solid...no matter what. To our donors, advocates and supporters we say thank you. To all others, we invite you to join us.

OUR SERVICES

HEALTHCARE SERVICES

Planned Parenthood continues to be the leading provider of sexual reproductive health care in the United States. Planned Parenthood of Metropolitan New Jersey provides reproductive health care to women who would otherwise not be able to afford gyn care. We offer wellness exams for men and women. In many cases, we are the primary health care provider for our clients. The breast exam and pap smears that we provide are major detectors of breast and cervical cancer. We are proud of the fact that more males are coming through our doors. PPMNJ offers services to all ages and confidentiality is our "brand". Our fastest growing population is women between the ages of twenty-one and twenty-four years old, with a total of over 4,700 clients in this age group.

In 2011, PPMNJ clients made over 28,500 visits to our six health centers. The clients are greeted with care and excellent customer service at each facility. PPMNJ provides STI treatment for both men and women. HIV testing is provided along with linkages of care for comprehensive HIV treatment to professional HIV treatment facilities. The HPV vaccine is now being offered to men as well as women. Colposcopies and cryosurgery are much needed medical procedures that continue to be offered at PPMNJ.

2011 HIGHLIGHTS

- As part of reaching out to the "faith-based" community, PPMNJ developed a linkage agreement with St. James AME Church, Newark, to provide on-site gonorrhea and chlamydia testing once a week.
- In an effort to streamline the Paterson and Pompton Lake supervisory budget, PPMNJ created a new position, "Regional Manager", combining the Paterson and Pompton Lakes center manager position into one position.
- Despite an 18% decrease in funding due to NJ state cuts, after consolidating operations, controlling client flow, and analyzing productivity. PPMNJ was able to meet level of service by 99.7%.
- In preparation for the implementation of NextGen, a new practice management system, a great deal training and research was invested in readying staff at our six centers. This will be a precursor to PPMNJ's entrée into electronic health records in 2012.

HEALTHCARE SERVICES

THE NUMBERS:

- 19,945 women, men and teens accessed PPMNJ services at one of our 6 health centers in Essex, Passaic and Hudson counties.
- 28,951 visits were made to our health centers.
- 2,002 men received healthcare services representing 10% of total clients served.
- 9,027 clients were screened for HIV.
- 1,599 emergency contraception kits were provided to clients.
- 3,175 pap smears and an additional 1,990 human papillomavirus (also called HPV) tests were provided.
- 11,387 breast exams were performed.
- 6,615 pregnancy tests were conducted.
- 113 colposcopies were performed to determine cervical cancer.
- 21 cryosurgeries (the use of extreme cold temperatures to destroy tissue for therapeutic purposes) were provided.

OUR SERVICES

PUBLIC AFFAIRS

For the past year Planned Parenthood of Metropolitan New Jersey has been working to ensure that our clients can reap positive results from the passage of the Client Protection and Affordable Care Act (Health Care Reform). PPMNJ has participated in a statewide effort with support from PPFA to ensure that women are better off after health care reform than they are today. Healthcare reform will significantly increase access to health care for women and our clients will be assured access to essential community providers like Planned Parenthood of Metropolitan New Jersey.

In 2011, PPMNJ also participated in a nationwide effort to support the Obama Administration's efforts to ensure that women have the access to preventative health care coverage they need such as breast and cervical cancer screening and birth control without the burden of copayments. Many people were surprised to find out just how expensive birth control coverage, even just the co-payments, is for women during their reproductive years and that 55% of young women have struggled to afford birth control.

EDUCATION & TRAINING

In the Family Life Institute (FLI) the education and training department of PPMNJ, professional educators provide programs that help young people develop into healthy adults and help adults raise healthy young people. The staff also provides training for youth-serving professionals so that they can become more competent and confident sexual health resources for their organizations.


The Teen LINKS (Leaders Impacting Neighbors Knowledge on Sexuality) program, offers teens a comprehensive 50 hour training to become teen peer health educators and performers. The teens work in schools and agencies throughout our service areas, presenting teen theater performances that educate, entertain and motivate their peer audiences.

FLI also offers two annual youth-development events through our Teen Life Conferences in Newark at the New Jersey Institute of Technology and in Passaic County at William Paterson University. These conferences provide workshops for hundreds of young people in those communities. In 2011, we held our most successful Teen Life Conference in Passaic. over 115 teens were in attendance


We are also proud of our Living Room Series. This program sends PPMNJ educators into the homes of families to provide customized workshops for parents and teens addressing sensitive information in the comfort of one's home. The Living Room Series is designed to create a new culture of openness for on-going communication between parents and teens.

FLI programs cover a wide range of topics including: developing decision-making and relationship skills and preventing unplanned pregnancies and sexually transmitted infections. Educators work in schools, homes and community based and faith based organizations. In 2011 Teen LINKS gave 28 performances for over 650 participants. Overall, the Family Life Institute, provided education to over 8,000 people in our three service areas of Essex, Passaic, and Hudson counties in New Jersey.
